We are a diverse group of researchers at Berlin University of the Arts and the University of Oxford. In the context of a new research collaboration, we are asking: How do people who are applying for asylum use smartphones, tablets, laptops ...? Do asylum seekers use smartphones to help them get settled in their destination country? To fill out forms? To maintain contact with home? Or might they even pose a risk?

To answer these questions, we want to carry out a participative workshop with people who have lived experiences with applying for asylum – regardless of whether this application was successful or not. We want to think about which of these questions are important, and maybe find some initial answers as well. 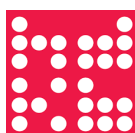
